

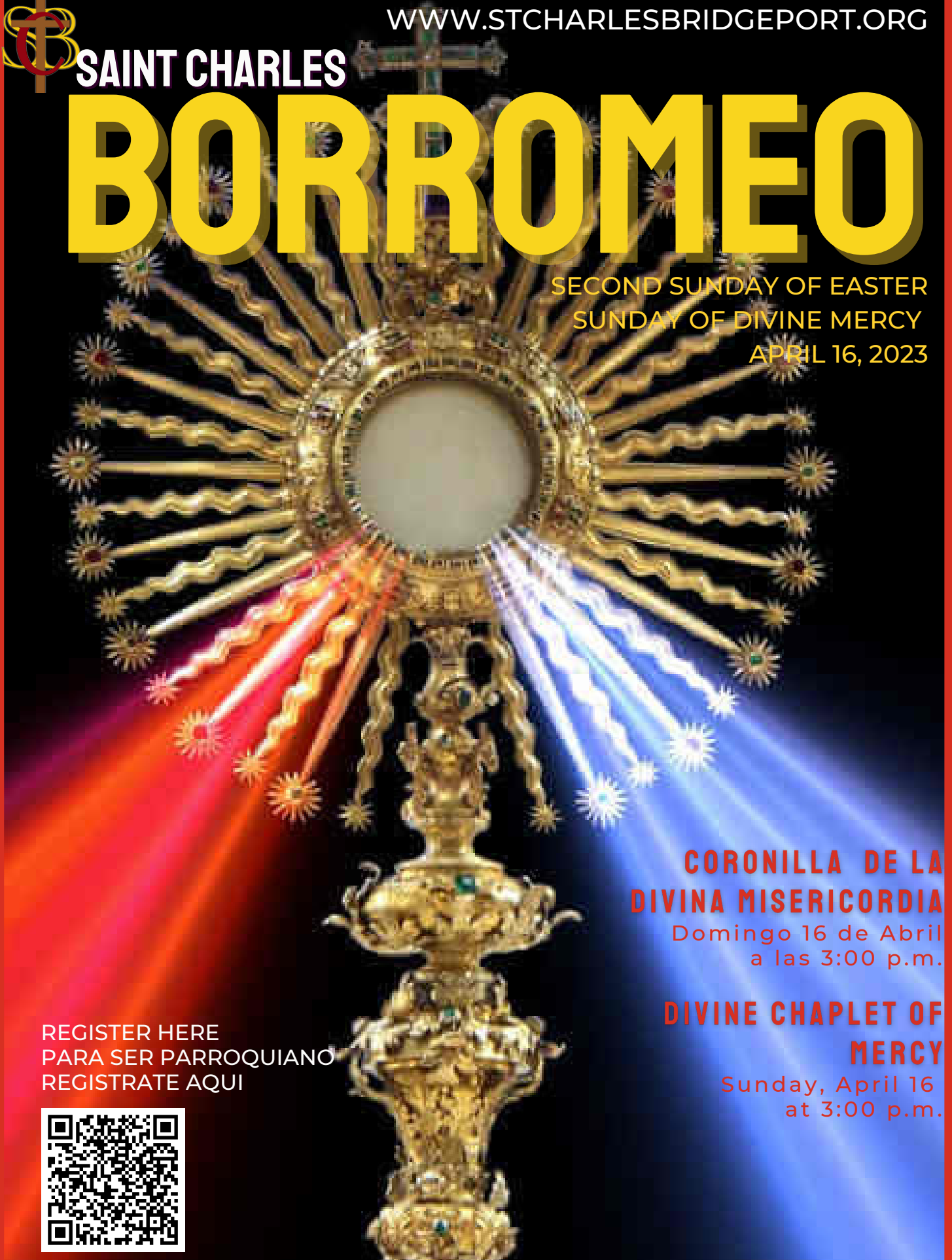

Queridos amigos,

Cristo Ha Resucitado! Verdaderamente Ha Resucitado! Aleluya!

No se si alguna vez has tenido una pesadilla, un mal sueño acerca de algún ser amado, que ha muerto y luego despiertas y ves que todo ha sido nada mas que un mal sueño. O quizás has tenido la experiencia triste de ver a un ser amado partir al Padre y quisieras que todo hubiese sido un mal sueño.

Ahora imagínate lo que sentían los discípulos que habían compartido todo con Jesús todos los días por mucho tiempo. Habían visto los milagros que había hecho, lo vieron reír, llorar por lázaro pero sobre todo experimentaron el amor de el cara a cara. Ellos también lo amaban, porque Jesús se hizo uno con ellos, pero por el miedo que sentían a la muerte a pesar de amarlo también lo traicionaron y lo abandonaron.

He vencido la muerte, para que tu puedas tener vida en abundancia. Para que tu puedas experimentar el perdón, para que puedas ser feliz aun en medio de la enfermedad y de los problemas, para que puedas amar como el nos ama.

La Pascua no es un solo día, la Iglesia celebra este maravilloso Misterio por 50 días. Y nos invita a ir y anunciar a todo aquel que no conoce a Jesucristo y decirle: Alegrarte, Dios te ama! Jesucristo ha muerto para que nosotros podamos salir de la muerte espiritual en la que vivimos y que podamos tener vida eterna, aquí en la tierra y en cielo. Deja que la alegría de esta buena noticia invada toda tu vida y déjala que se haga una con tu tristeza, con tu desesperación, con tu necesidad de sentirte amado, con tu mirada, con tu manera de hablar y actuar, para que tu también puedas resucitar con Jesucristo.

FROM THE PASTOR'S OFFICE

Dear Friends:

Christ is Risen! He is Truly Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!

I don't know if you've ever had a bad dream about someone you love dying, and then you wake up and see that it was all just a bad dream. Or perhaps you have had the sad experience of seeing a loved one go to the Father and you wish it had all been a bad dream.

Now imagine what the disciples felt; they had shared everything with Jesus every single day for a long time. They had seen the miracles he had done, they saw him laugh, cry for Lazarus but above all they experienced His love face to face. They also loved him, because Jesus had made himself one with them, but because of their fear of death, despite loving him, they also betrayed him and abandoned him.

Surely they felt disappointed in themselves, without any hope, full of sadness, with no one to comfort them anymore. Surely they were confused, without direction, not knowing what to do or where to go. And suddenly they hear the Good News! that Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! He didn't stay dead, he was alive! Everything he told them was true! Imagine the joy of these women when they saw him! And the first thing he tells them is DO NOT BE AFRAID! He was not angry, full of complaints or judgments against them. On the contrary, he loved them and felt tenderness for his brothers who were so poor and weak in their faith and he knew they were suffering so much. His heart was full of love, and he tells the women: Go and announce to my brothers to go to Galilee. and there they will see me.

Today is a day of happiness and joy for us Christians! Our hope has been restored! Jesus tells us too, DO NOT BE AFRAID! I am alive! I have defeated death, so that you can have life in abundance. So that you can experience forgiveness, so that you can be happy even in the midst of your sickness and your problems, so that you can love in the same way that he loves us.

Easter is not a single day, the Church celebrates this wonderful mystery for 50 days, and invites us to go and announce to everyone who does not know Jesus Christ and tell them: Rejoice, God loves you! Jesus Christ has died so that we can get out of the spiritual death in which we live and we may have eternal life, here on earth and in heaven. Let the joy of this good news invade your whole life and let it become one with your sadness, with your despair, with your need to feel loved, with the way to look at people, with the way you speak and act towards others, so that you too can resurrect with Jesus Christ. Let's rejoice Brothers and Sisters and announce to everyone that CHRIST IS RISEN!
