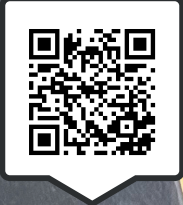

II. GOD REVEAL HIS NAME

This section focuses on how God reveals Himself to the people of Israel by sharing His name, which embodies His essence, identity, and the nature of His relationship with humanity. A name is more than just a label; it carries profound significance, allowing for a deeper understanding and a more personal connection with the divine. By disclosing His name, God becomes accessible to His people, inviting them to engage with Him on a more intimate level.

The concept of progressive revelation is emphasized, illustrating that God has gradually revealed Himself through various names throughout history. The most significant moment occurs when God speaks to Moses from the burning bush, marking a pivotal point for both the Old and New Covenants. This encounter establishes a deeper relationship between God and His people, particularly in the context of their liberation and covenant identity.

In this Divine revelation, God identifies Himself as "the God of your father, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob." This connection to the patriarchs highlights God's unwavering faithfulness and His commitment to the promises made to them over generations. It reinforces the idea that God is not a distant figure but an active participant in the lives of His chosen people, deeply involved in their history and well-being.

Finally, the passage presents God as both compassionate and powerful. His ability to act beyond time and space is evident in His intention to free the Israelites from slavery, demonstrating His desire to save and guide them. This act of liberation reinforces His role as a protector, underscoring His active engagement in human affairs. Overall, this section illustrates the profound significance of God's name and its relationship to His nature, promises, and ongoing involvement in the lives of His people.

Queridos Amigos,

II. DIOS REVELA SU NOMBRE

Esta sección se centra en cómo Dios se revela a su pueblo Israel al compartir Su nombre, el cual encarna Su esencia, identidad y la naturaleza de Su relación con la humanidad. Un nombre es más que una simple etiqueta; lleva un profundo significado, permitiendo una comprensión más profunda y una conexión más personal con lo divino. Al revelar Su nombre, Dios se vuelve accesible a Su pueblo, invitándolos a relacionarse con Él a un nivel más íntimo.

Se enfatiza el concepto de revelación progresiva, ilustrando que Dios ha revelado gradualmente Su esencia a través de diversos nombres a lo largo de la historia. El momento más significativo ocurre cuando Dios habla a Moisés desde la zarza ardiente, marcando un punto crucial tanto para el Antiguo como para el Nuevo Pacto. Este encuentro establece una relación más profunda entre Dios y Su pueblo, especialmente en el contexto de su liberación e identidad como pacto.

En esta Revelación divina, Dios se identifica como "el Dios de tu padre, el Dios de Abraham, el Dios de Isaac y el Dios de Jacob." Esta conexión con los patriarcas resalta la fidelidad inquebrantable de Dios y Su compromiso con las promesas hechas a ellos a lo largo de las generaciones. Reforza la idea de que Dios no es una figura distante, sino un participante activo en la vida de Su pueblo elegido, profundamente involucrado en su historia y bienestar.

Finalmente, el pasaje presenta a Dios como compasivo y poderoso. 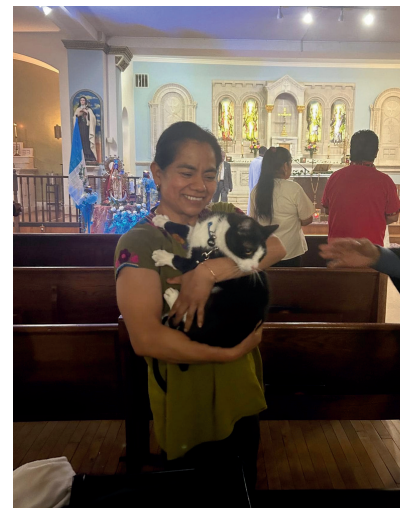
