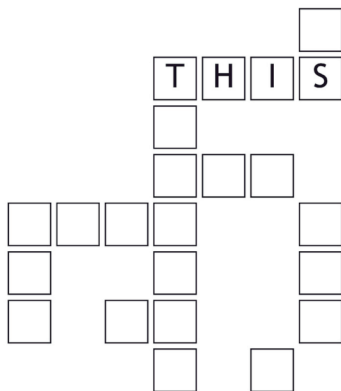
Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to take away my sins.

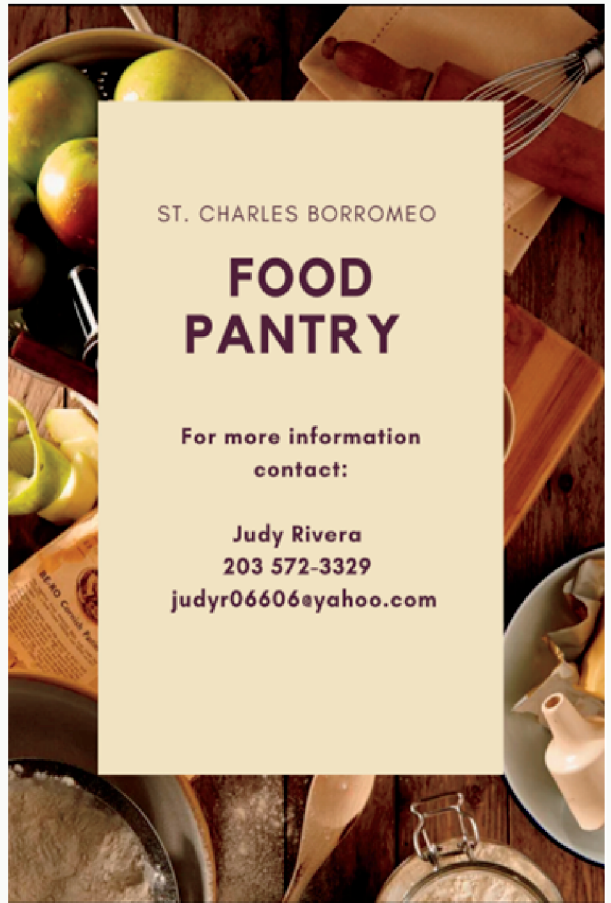
