San Carlos Borromeo



Carlos Borromeo (1538-1584) era hijo del conde Gilbert Borromeo y Margaret Medici, hermana del Papa Pío IV. Nació en el castillo familiar de Arona en el Lago Maggiore, Italia el 2 de octubre. Recibió la tonsura clerical cuando tenía doce años y fue enviado a la abadía benedictina de SS. Graciano y Felino en Arona para su educación.

En 1559, su tío fue elegido Papa Pío IV y al año siguiente, lo nombró su Secretario de Estado y lo creó cardenal y administrador de la sede de Milán. Se desempeñó como legado de Pío en numerosas misiones diplomáticas y en 1562 fue fundamental para que Pío volviera a convocar el Concilio de Trento, que había sido suspendido en 1552.

Charles desempeñó un papel principal en la orientación y la elaboración de los decretos del tercer y último grupo de sesiones. Rechazó la jefatura de la familia Borromeo a la muerte del conde Federico Borromeo, fue ordenado sacerdote en 1563 y consagrado obispo de Milán el mismo año. Antes de que se le permitiera tomar posesión de su sede, supervisó el catecismo, el misal y el breviario solicitados por el Concilio de Trento.

Cuando finalmente llegó a Trento (que había estado sin obispo residente durante ochenta años) en 1556, instituyó reformas radicales a pesar de la gran oposición, con tal eficacia que se convirtió en una sede modelo. Puso en práctica medidas para mejorar la moral y las costumbres del clero y de los laicos, elevó la eficacia de la operación diocesana, estableció seminarios para la educación del clero, fundó una Cofradía de Doctrina Cristiana para la instrucción religiosa de los niños y animó a los jesuitas en su sede.

Aumentó los sistemas para los pobres y los necesitados, fue muy generoso en su ayuda al colegio inglés en Douai, y durante su obispado celebró once sínodos diocesanos y seis consejos provinciales. Fundó una sociedad de sacerdotes seculares, Oblatos de San Ambrosio (ahora Oblatos de San Carlos) en 1578, y participó activamente en la predicación, resistiendo las incursiones del protestantismo y trayendo de vuelta a la Iglesia a los católicos no practicantes. Encontró oposición de muchas fuentes en sus esfuerzos por reformar personas e instituciones.

Murió en Milán la noche del 3 al 4 de noviembre y fue canonizado en 1610. Fue una de las figuras destacadas de la Reforma Católica, mecenas del aprendizaje y las artes, y aunque alcanzó una posición de gran poder, usó con humildad, santidad personal y desinterés para reformar la Iglesia, de los males y abusos tan frecuentes entre el clero y los nobles de la época. Él es el patrón del aprendizaje y las artes.

FROM THE PASTOR'S OFFICE

Dear brothers and sisters,

As many of you know, this week we are approaching the feast of Saint Charles Borromeo, patron saint of bishops, cardinals, seminarians, and spiritual leaders. Very importantly, he is also the Patron Saint of our Parish which bears his name. We will also be celebrating our Parish's 120th Anniversary! We celebrate this feast on Saturday with the Holy Eucharist, all together and presided by our Bishop Frank J. Caggiano at 5:30 p.m.

With this very important day in mind, I invite you to read a little bit about his history below and encourage you all TO PRAY and ask for his intercession. Pray for whatever intentions you may have in your heart, and most especially pray for our Bishop Caggiano, Priests and Deacons, and all the families who faithfully attend our Parish, that the Lord may grant us the grace to be faithful to Him and to The Vocation to which He has called each of us.

Charles Borromeo (1538-1584) was the son of Count Gilbert Borromeo and Margaret Medici, sister of Pope Pius IV. He was born at the family castle of Arona on Lake Maggiore, Italy on October 2. He received the clerical tonsure when he was twelve and was sent to the Benedictine abbey of SS. Gratian and Felinus at Arona for his education.

In 1559, his uncle was elected Pope Pius IV and the following year, named him his Secretary of State and created him a cardinal and administrator of the see of Milan. He served as Pius' legate on numerous diplomatic missions and in 1562, was instrumental in having Pius reconvene the Council of Trent, which had been suspended in 1552.

Charles played a leading role in guiding and fashioning the decrees of the third and last group of sessions. He refused the headship of the Borromeo family on the death of Count Frederick Borromeo, was ordained a priest in 1563 and was consecrated bishop of Milan the same year. Before being allowed to take possession of his see, he oversaw the catechism, missal, and breviary called for by the Council of Trent.

When he finally did arrive at Trent (which had been without a resident bishop for eighty years) in 1556, he instituted radical reforms despite great opposition, with such effectiveness that it became a model see. He put into effect, measures to improve the morals and manners of the clergy and laity, raised the effectiveness of the diocesan operation, established seminaries for the education of the clergy, founded a Confraternity of Christian Doctrine for the religious instruction of children, and encouraged the Jesuits in his see.

He increased the systems to the poor and the needy, was most generous in his help to the English college at Douai, and during his bishopric held eleven diocesan synods and six provincial councils. He founded a society of secular priests, Oblates of St. Ambrose (now Oblates of St. Charles) in 1578, and was active in preaching, resisting the inroads of Protestantism, and bringing back lapsed Catholics to the Church. He encountered opposition from many sources in his efforts to reform people and institutions.

He died in Milan on the night of November 3-4 and was canonized in 1610. He was one of the towering figures of the Catholic Reformation, a patron of learning and the arts, and though he achieved a position of great power, he used it with humility, personal sanctity, and unselfishness to reform the Church, of the evils and abuses so prevalent among the clergy and the nobles of the times. He is the patron of learning and the arts.


