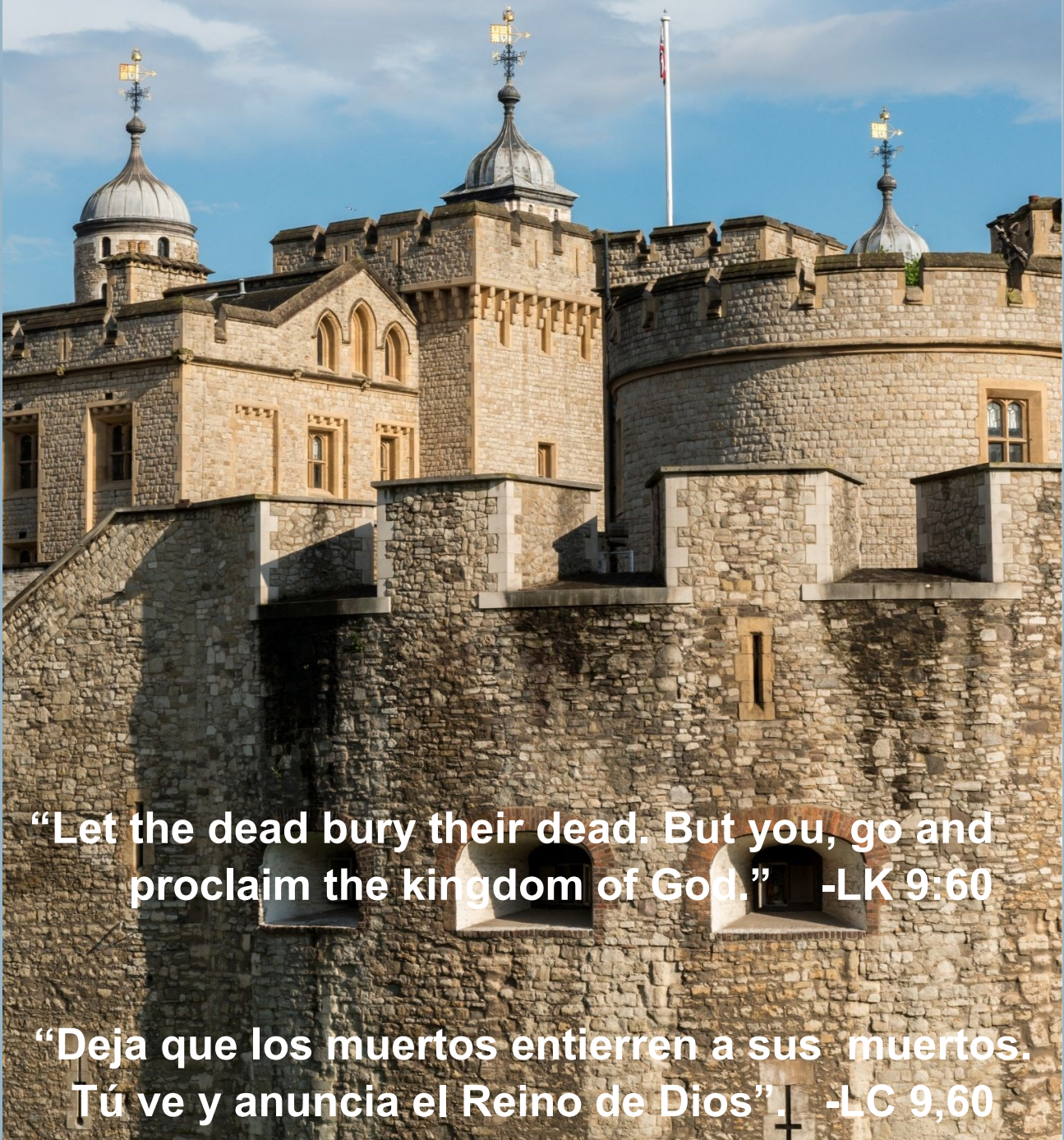

**Saint Charles Parish Needs You and You Need Saint Charles Parish!**

By registering at a parish, you are declaring your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. If you have recently moved to the area or if you are a long-time resident, please consider registering at the parish where you participate. There's usually information in a parish bulletin or in the pew racks about how to register. When in doubt, ask a priest after Mass. In most cases, you will need to visit the parish office and fill out a simple form or register online.

**Top Reasons to Register at a Parish**

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you. This is especially important during a time of crisis so that the pastoral staff can attend to your spiritual needs and the needs of your family.
- Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you. Providing your contact information is important so that parishes provide you timely updates via email, direct mail, phone, etc. Also, if you use offertory envelopes or online giving, you will also receive a year-end statement of your donations for income tax purposes. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.
- Registered active members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation.
- Registered active members are sometimes eligible to rent parish facilities.
- Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.

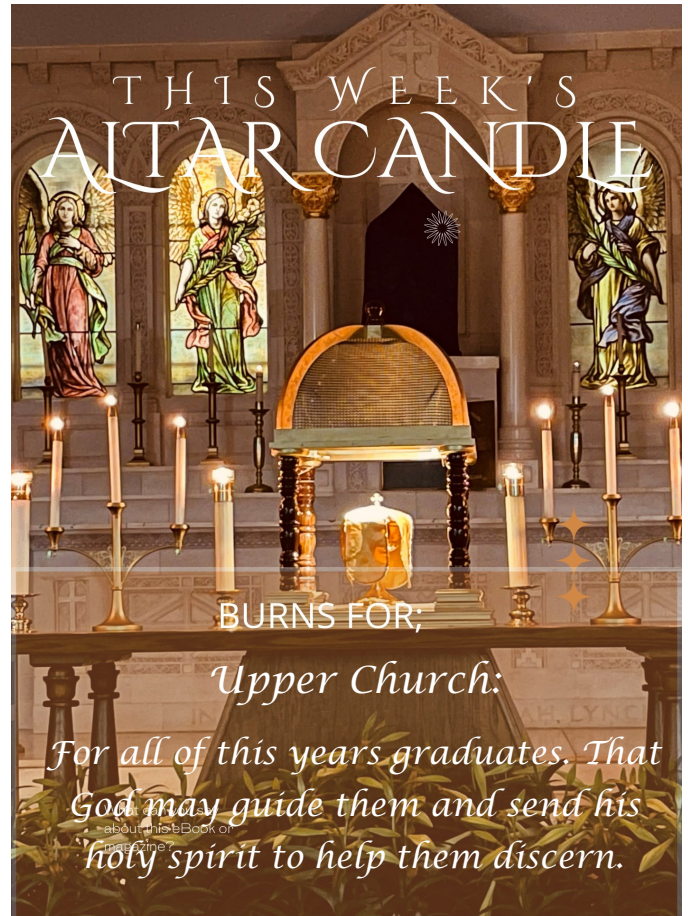

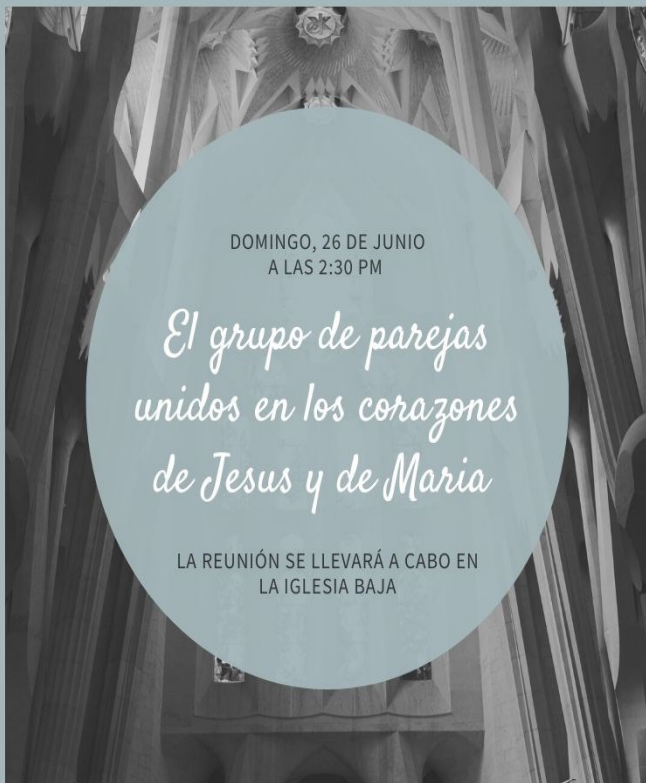

Dear brothers and sisters,

Throughout the next few weeks, I will be inviting you to read and reflect on different letters and homilies from various saints. It is important as Catholics that our church know the life and thoughts of the Saints, since we are called to be saints. We will find in them a lot of wisdom and knowledge, but they will also be of great consolation to us.

(Hom. *Maniliae habita die 29 novembris 1970*)

**WE PROCLAIM CHRIST TO THE WHOLE WORLD**

*Not to preach the Gospel would be my undoing*, for Christ himself sent me as his apostle and witness. The more remote, the more difficult the assignment, the more *my love of God spurs me on*. I am bound to proclaim that Jesus is *Christ, the Son of the living God*. Because of him we come to know the God we cannot see. *He is the firstborn of all creation; in him all things find their being*. Man's teacher and redeemer, he was born for us, died for us, and for us he rose from the dead. All things, all history converges in Christ. A man of sorrow and hope, he knows us and loves us. As our friend he stays by us throughout our lives; at the end of time he will come to be our judge; but we also know that he will be the complete fulfillment of our lives and our great happiness for all eternity. I can never cease to speak of Christ for he is our truth and our light; *he is the way, the truth and the life*. He is our bread, our source of living water who allays our hunger and satisfies our thirst. He is our shepherd, our leader, our ideal, our comforter and our brother. He is like us but more perfectly human, simple, poor, humble, and yet, while burdened with work, he is more patient. He spoke on our behalf; he worked miracles; and he founded a new kingdom: in it the poor are happy; peace is the foundation of a life in common; where the pure of heart and those who mourn are uplifted and comforted; the hungry find justice; sinners are forgiven; and all discover that they are brothers. The image I present to you is the image of Jesus Christ. As Christians you share his name; he has already made most of you his own. So once again I repeat his name to you Christians and I proclaim to all men: Jesus Christ is the beginning and the end, the alpha and the omega, Lord of the new universe, the great hidden key to human history and the part we play in it. He is the mediator—the bridge, if you will—between heaven and earth. Above all he is the Son of man, more perfect than any man, being also the Son of God, eternal and infinite. He is the son of Mary his mother on earth, more blessed than any woman. She is also our mother in the spiritual communion of the mystical body. Remember: [it] is Jesus Christ I preach day in and day out. His name I would see echo and re-echo for all time even to the ends of the earth.

**PREDICAMOS A RISTO HASTA LOS CONFINES DE LA TIERRA**

¡Ay de mí si no anuncio el Evangelio! Para esto me ha enviado el mismo Cristo. Yo soy apóstol y testigo. Cuanto más lejana está la meta, cuanto más difícil es el mandato, con tanta mayor vehemencia nos apremia el amor. Debo predicar su nombre: Jesucristo es el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios vivo; él es quien nos ha revelado al Dios invisible, él es el primogénito de toda criatura, y todo se mantiene en él. Él es también el maestro y redentor de los hombres; él nació, murió y resucitó por nosotros. Él es el centro de la historia y del universo; él nos conoce y nos ama, compañero y amigo de nuestra vida, hombre de dolor y de esperanza; él, ciertamente, vendrá de nuevo y será finalmente nuestro juez y también, como esperamos, nuestra plenitud de vida y nuestra felicidad. 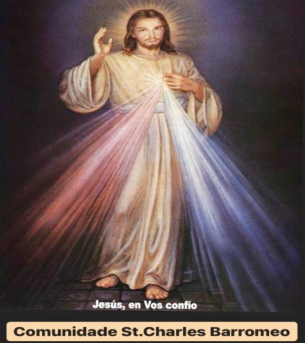
