


Saint Charles Parish Needs You and You Need Saint Charles Parish!

By registering at a parish, you are declaring your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. If you have recently moved to the area or if you are a long-time resident, please consider registering at the parish where you participate. There's usually information in a parish bulletin or in the pew racks about how to register. When in doubt, ask a priest after Mass. In most cases, you will need to visit the parish office and fill out a simple form or register online.

Top Reasons to Register at a Parish

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you. This is especially important during a time of crisis so that the pastoral staff can attend to your spiritual needs and the needs of your family.
- Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you. Providing your contact information is important so that parishes provide you timely updates via email, direct mail, phone, etc. Also, if you use offertory envelopes or online giving, you will also receive a year-end statement of your donations for income tax purposes. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.
- Registered active members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation.
- Registered active members are sometimes eligible to rent parish facilities.
- Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Whether you know him as the man who brought Christianity to Ireland or simply as a reason you eat corned beef and cabbage in March, St. Patrick (415 – 493) is a well-known saint around the world. St. Patrick was born in Britain of a Romanized family. At the age of 16, he was kidnapped by Irish raiders from the villa of his father, a deacon and local official, and brought into slavery in Ireland. He spent six long years there as a herdsman, during which he turned to his faith for strength. He later escaped back to Britain on a ship, where he was eventually reunited with his family. His years of captivity changed him and brought out a zeal for God and a yearning to spread the message of Jesus Christ. Despite the constant danger of martyrdom, he continued to travel throughout Ireland where he baptized and confirmed in the name of Christ.



Throughout the next few weeks, I will be inviting you to read and reflect on different letters and homilies from various saints. It is important as Catholics that our church know the life and thoughts of the Saints, since we are called to be saints. We will find in them a lot of wisdom and knowledge, but they will also be of great consolation to us.



From a sermon by Saint Leo the Great, pope

(*Sermo 51, 3-4. 8: PL 54, 310-311. 313*)

THE LAW WAS GIVEN THROUGH MOSES, GRACE AND TRUTH CAME THROUGH JESUS CHRIST

The Lord reveals his glory in the presence of chosen witnesses. His body is like that of the rest of mankind, but he makes it shine with such splendor that his face becomes like the sun in glory, and his garments as white as snow. The great reason for this transfiguration was to remove the scandal of the cross from the hearts of his disciples, and to prevent the humiliation of his voluntary suffering from disturbing the faith of those who had witnessed the surpassing glory that lay concealed. With no less forethought he was also providing a firm foundation for the hope of holy Church. The whole body of Christ was to understand the kind of transformation that it would receive as his gift. The members of that body were to look forward to a share in that glory which first blazed out in Christ their head. The Lord had himself spoken of this when he foretold the splendor of his coming: *Then the just will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father.* Saint Paul the apostle bore witness to this same truth when he said: *I consider that the sufferings of the present time are not to be compared with the future glory that is to be revealed in us.* In another place he says: *You are dead, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, your life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with him in glory.* This marvel of the transfiguration contains another lesson for the apostles, to strengthen them and lead them into the fullness of knowledge. Moses and Elijah, the law and the prophets, appeared with the Lord in conversation with him. This was in order to fulfill exactly, through the presence of these five men, the text which says: *Before two or three witnesses every word is ratified.* What word could be more firmly established, more securely based, than the word which is proclaimed by the trumpets of both old and new testaments, sounding in harmony, and by the utterances of ancient prophecy and the teaching of the Gospel, in full agreement with each other? The writings of the two testaments support each other. The radiance of the transfiguration reveals clearly and unmistakably the one who had been promised by signs foretelling him under the veils of mystery. As Saint John says: *The law was given through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.* In him the promise made through the shadows of prophecy stands revealed, along with the full meaning of the precepts of the law. He is the one who teaches the truth of prophecy through his presence, and makes obedience to the commandments possible through grace. In the preaching of the holy Gospel all should receive a strengthening of their faith. No one should be ashamed of the cross of Christ, through which the world has been redeemed. No one should fear to suffer for the sake of justice; no one should lose confidence in the reward that has been promised. The way to rest is through toil, the way to life is through death. Christ has taken on himself the whole weakness of our lowly human nature. If then we are steadfast in our faith in him and in our love for him, we win the victory that he has won, we receive what he has promised. When it comes to obeying the commandments or enduring adversity, the words uttered by the Father should always echo in our ears: *This is my Son, the beloved, in whom I am well pleased; listen to him.*

LA LEY SE DIO POR MEDIO DE MOISÉS, LA GRACIA Y LA VERDAD VINIERON POR MEDIO DE JESUCRISTO

El Señor puso de manifiesto su gloria ante los testigos que había elegido, e hizo resplandecer de tal manera aquel cuerpo suyo, semejante al de todos los hombres, que su rostro se volvió semejante a la claridad del sol y sus vestiduras aparecieron blancas como la nieve. En aquella transfiguración se trataba, sobre todo, de alejar de los corazones de los discípulos el escándalo de la cruz, y evitar así que la humillación de la pasión voluntaria conturbara la fe de aquellos a quienes se había revelado la excelencia de la dignidad escondida. Pero con no menor providencia se estaba fundamentando la esperanza de la Iglesia santa, ya que el cuerpo de Cristo, en su totalidad, podría comprender cuál habría de ser su transformación, y sus miembros podrían contar con la promesa de su participación en aquel honor que brillaba de antemano en la cabeza. A propósito de lo cual había dicho el mismo Señor, al hablar de la majestad de su venida: Entonces los justos brillarán como el sol en el reino de su Padre. Cosa que el mismo apóstol Pablo corroboró, diciendo: Sostengo que los sufrimientos de ahora nopesan lo que la gloria que un día se nos descubrirá; y de nuevo: Habéis muerto, y vuestra vida está con Cristo escondida en Dios. Cuando aparezca Cristo, vida nuestra, entonces también vosotros apareceréis, juntamente con él, en gloria. Pero, en aquel milagro, hubo también otra lección para confirmación y completo conocimiento de los apóstoles. Pues aparecieron, en conversación con el Señor, Moisés y Elías, es decir, la ley y los profetas, para que se cumpliera con toda verdad, en presencia de aquellos cinco hombres, lo que está escrito: Toda palabra quede confirmada por boca de dos o tres testigos. ¿Y pudo haber una palabra más firmemente establecida que ésta, en cuyo anuncio resuena la trompeta de ambos Testamentos y concurren las antiguas enseñanzas con la doctrina evangélica? Las páginas de los dos Testamentos se apoyaban entre sí, y el esplendor de la actual gloria ponía de manifiesto, a plena luz, a aquel que los anteriores signos habían prometido bajo el velo de sus misterios; porque, como dice san Juan, la ley se dio por medio de Moisés, la gracia y la verdad vinieron por medio de Jesucristo, en quien se cumplieron, a la vez, la promesa de las figuras proféticas y la razón de los preceptos legales, ya que, con su presencia, atestiguó la verdad de las profecías y, con su gracia, otorgó a los mandamientos la posibilidad de su cumplimiento. Que la predicación del santo Evangelio sirva, por tanto, para la confirmación de la fe de todos, y que nadie se avergüenze de la cruz de Cristo, gracias a la cual el mundo ha sido redimido. Que nadie tema sufrir por la justicia, ni desconfie del cumplimiento de las promesas, porque por el trabajo se va al descanso, y por la muerte se pasa a la vida; pues el Señor echó sobre sí toda la debilidad de nuestra condición, y, si nos mantenemos en su amor, venceremos lo que él venció y recibiremos lo que prometió. En efecto, ya se trate de cumplir los mandamientos o de tolerar las adversidades, nunca debe dejar de resonar en nuestros oídos la palabra pronunciada por el Padre: Éste es mi Hijo, el amado, mi predilecto; escuchadlo.





