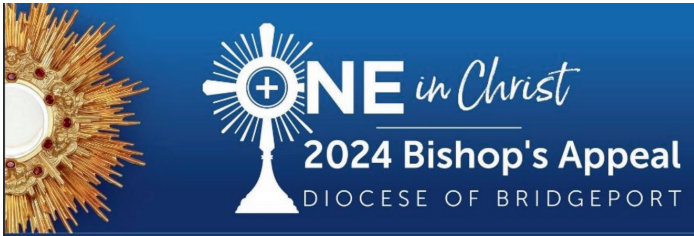

FROM THE PASTOR'S OFFICE

Dear Friends,

When Jesus returned to his hometown with his disciples, he chose to teach in the synagogue on the Sabbath. His teachings and the miracles he performed left many amazed and in awe. However, among the crowd, doubts and resistance also arose. Some wondered in astonishment, "Where did this man get all this wisdom? How can he perform such powerful deeds with his hands? Isn't he the carpenter, the son of Mary? Aren't his brothers, James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon, here with us? And aren't his sisters here as well?"

These questions revealed a lack of faith rooted in disbelief that someone so familiar and close could manifest such divine power. Instead of opening their hearts to the possibility that Jesus was more than just a familiar neighbor, some took offense at his teachings and miracles.

In response to the disbelief and lack of respect shown to him, Jesus shared a profound teaching: "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown, among his relatives, and in his own household." This statement underscores the irony of how familiarity can often blind us to the greatness and divine purpose present in those who have been around us all along.

As a result of the lack of faith in his hometown community, Jesus could not perform many miracles there. Despite this, he continued to show compassion and healed some sick people who came to him with humility and faith.

This story invites us to reflect on how our familiarity with people and situations can influence our perception of God's presence in our lives. It challenges us to open our hearts and minds, allowing faith and expectation of the divine to lead us to a deeper understanding and reception of the blessings that God desires to give us.

DE LA OFICINA DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos amigos,

Cuando Jesús regresó a su pueblo natal junto a sus discípulos, decidió enseñar en la sinagoga durante el día de reposo. Su enseñanza y los milagros que realizaba dejaron a muchos impresionados y maravillados. Sin embargo, entre la multitud también surgieron dudas y resistencias. Algunos se preguntaban sorprendidos: "¿De dónde ha sacado este hombre toda esta sabiduría? ¿Cómo puede realizar tales obras poderosas con sus manos? ¿No es acaso el carpintero, el hijo de María? ¿No están aquí con nosotros sus hermanos, Santiago, José, Judas y Simón? ¿Y no están también aquí sus hermanas?"

Estas preguntas revelaban una falta de fe arraigada en la incredulidad de que alguien tan conocido y cercano pudiera manifestar tal poder divino. En lugar de abrir sus corazones a la posibilidad de que Jesús fuera más que simplemente un vecino conocido, algunos se sintieron ofendidos por su enseñanza y sus milagros.

En respuesta a la incredulidad y la falta de respeto mostrada hacia él, Jesús compartió una enseñanza profunda: "Un profeta no es valorado en su propio pueblo, entre sus parientes y en su propia casa". Esta afirmación subraya la ironía de cómo la familiaridad a menudo puede cegarnos ante la grandeza y el propósito divino presentes en aquellos que nos rodean desde siempre.

Como consecuencia de la falta de fe en su comunidad natal, Jesús no pudo realizar muchos milagros allí. A pesar de ello, no dejó de mostrar compasión y sanó a algunos enfermos que vinieron a él con humildad y fe.

Esta historia nos invita a reflexionar sobre cómo nuestra familiaridad con las personas y las situaciones puede influir en nuestra percepción de la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas. Nos desafía a abrir nuestros corazones y mentes, permitiendo que la fe y la expectativa de lo divino nos guíen hacia una mayor comprensión y recepción de las bendiciones que Dios desea otorgarnos.

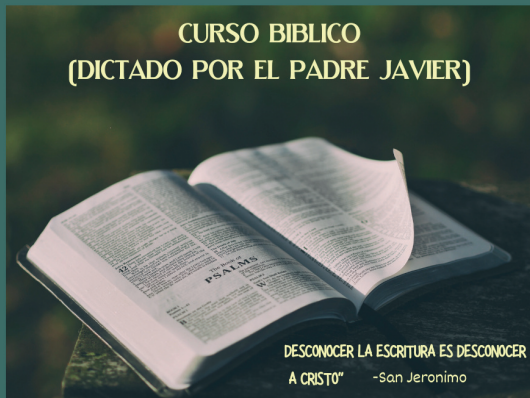
