Reflection sur quadrieme Dimanche Carême Annee C, 2025

Freres, si quelqu'un est dans le Christ , il est une creature nouvelle. Le monde ancien s'en est alle, un monde nouveau est Deja ne.

Les trois lecture de ce jour on en commun de nous confronter a la nouveaute:La nouveaute de la terre promise, la nouveaute du pardon en Christ, la nouveaute du retour du frere. A chaque foi, il nous est demander de changer de comportement. La vie dans la foi n'est jamais fixee une fois pour toute et elle peut amener des changements radicaux dand notre vie. Ce Dimanche du leatare est un Dimanche de joie qui doit nous preparer a accueillir la joie de Paques en accueillant cette nouveaute de la resurrection dans nos vies.

En Josue 5, premier des livres prophetiques, le Seigneur signifie a son peuple que le temps du desert est fini et qu'il convient de s'adapter a une realite nouvelle: le temps de l'esclavage en Egypte est fini, la terre promise est donnee, il n'y a plus de desert a parcourir en nomade mais des champs a cultiver en sedentaire.

En 2 Corinthiens, Paul est dans la meme ligne. En Christ nous sommes des creatures Nouvelles.. Un monde nouveau est la. Ce qui caracterise et doit caracteriser notre vie nouvelle en Christ, C'est la reconciliation, le pardon des peches. Laissons nous reconcillier avec le Christ, avec nos freres et avec nous memes. Il ne s'agit plus de faire penitence, ni de gemit, ni de plaindre, mais bien d'accueillir dans nos vies le pardon et vivre comme des hommes et de femmes reconcillier avec le Christ et avec nos freres.

Luc 15 illustre bien le propos de Paul avec le parabole du fils prodigue. Nous portons souvent l'accent sur le repentir du fils plus jeune. Pourtant quand on regarde bien l'evangile, autant de temps est consacre au fils aine qu'au plus jeune. Le plus jeune des fils est rentre dans le monde nouveau, sans rien faire de special que de reconnaitre ses peches. Le fils aine est reste dans le monde ancien en refusant de pardonner et en laissant dominer par la jalousie.

Nous sommes souvent beaucoup plus proches du fils aine que du plus jeune. A paques, nous avons a accueillir un salut et un pardon des peches qui dépassent nos regles toutes faites et nos categories qui enferment. Le notre pere que nous recitons chaque jour nous indique clairement que si nous ne pardonnons pas aux autre, nous ne serons pas pardones.

FROM THE PASTOR'S OFFICE

Brothers and sisters, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old world has passed away, and a new one has begun.

Today's readings invite us to confront newness: the newness of the promised land, the newness of forgiveness in Christ, and the newness of the return of the brother. We are called to change our behavior. Life in faith is dynamic and can bring radical changes. This Sunday of Laetare is one of joy, preparing us to welcome the joy of Easter by embracing the newness of the resurrection in our lives.

In Joshua 5, the Lord tells His people that the time of the desert is over. They are no longer nomads but are to settle and cultivate the promised land. In 2 Corinthians, Paul affirms that in Christ, we are new creations. Our new life in Christ is marked by reconciliation and forgiveness. Let us be reconciled with Christ, with our brothers, and with ourselves.

In the parable of the prodigal son (Luke 15), we see both sons—one enters the new world of forgiveness by recognizing his sins, while the other stays in the old world, consumed by jealousy and refusal to forgive. Often, we resemble the older son more than the younger. At Easter, we are called to embrace a forgiveness that transcends our rigid rules. The "Our Father" reminds us that if we don't forgive others, we won't be forgiven.

Hermanos y hermanas, si alguien está en Cristo, es una nueva creación. El mundo antiguo ha pasado, y ya ha comenzado uno nuevo.

Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a confrontar la novedad: la novedad de la tierra prometida, la novedad del perdón en Cristo y la novedad del regreso del hermano. Se nos llama a cambiar nuestro comportamiento. La vida en la fe es dinámica y puede traer cambios radicales. Este Domingo de Laetare es un día de alegría, que nos prepara para recibir la alegría de la Pascua al acoger la novedad de la resurrección en nuestras vidas.

En Josué 5, el Señor dice a su pueblo que el tiempo del desierto ha terminado. Ya no son nómadas, sino que deben asentarse y cultivar la tierra prometida. En 2 Corintios, Pablo afirma que en Cristo somos nuevas criaturas. Nuestra nueva vida en Cristo se caracteriza por la reconciliación y el perdón. Dejémonos reconciliar con Cristo, con nuestros hermanos y con nosotros mismos.

En la parábola del hijo pródigo (Lucas 15), vemos a ambos hijos: uno entra en el nuevo mundo del perdón al reconocer sus pecados, mientras que el otro permanece en el mundo antiguo, consumido por los celos y la negativa a perdonar. A menudo, nos parecemos más al hijo mayor que al menor. En la Pascua, se nos llama a abrazar un perdón que trasciende nuestras reglas rígidas. El "Padre Nuestro" nos recuerda que si no perdonamos a los demás, no seremos perdonados.

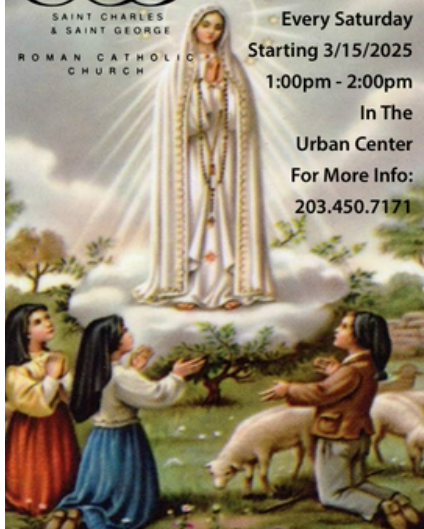
