II. THE REVELATION OF GOD AS TRINITY

The Father revealed by the Son

Jesus revealed God as Father in a unique and profound way. While God is Father in the sense of being the Creator, Jesus showed that God is eternally Father through His relationship with the Son. The Father and Son share an intimate, reciprocal relationship, where the Father knows the Son, and the Son, in turn, knows the Father. The Son can also reveal the Father to others, offering a deeper understanding of God's nature.

This revelation led the apostles to declare Jesus as the Word, acknowledging Him as both distinct and fully divine. They recognized Jesus as "the image of the invisible God," the "radiance of God's glory," and the "stamp of His nature," as described in the scriptures. Through this understanding, Jesus is identified not just as a messenger, but as the divine expression of God's essence.

At the First Council of Nicaea in 325, the Church formally declared the Son as "consubstantial" with the Father, meaning He is of the same substance or essence, fully God. This was reaffirmed at the Second Ecumenical Council in Constantinople in 381, which confirmed the Nicene Creed, describing the Son as "eternally begotten" of the Father, "light from light," and "true God from true God," affirming the belief in the Son's full divinity and unity with the Father.

Queridos Amigos,

II. LA REVELACIÓN DE DIOS COMO TRINIDAD

El Padre revelado por el Hijo

Jesús reveló a Dios como Padre de una manera única y profunda. Aunque Dios es Padre en el sentido de ser Creador, Jesús mostró que Dios es eternamente Padre a través de su relación con el Hijo. El Padre y el Hijo comparten una relación íntima y recíproca, donde el Padre conoce al Hijo, y el Hijo, a su vez, conoce al Padre. Además, el Hijo tiene la capacidad de revelar al Padre a los demás, ofreciendo una comprensión más profunda de la naturaleza de Dios.

Esta revelación llevó a los apóstoles a declarar a Jesús como la Palabra, reconociéndolo como distinto y plenamente divino. Lo describieron como "la imagen del Dios invisible," "el resplandor de su gloria," y "el sello de su naturaleza," tal como se menciona en las escrituras. A través de esta comprensión, Jesús es identificado no solo como un mensajero, sino como la expresión divina de la esencia de Dios.

En el Primer Concilio de Nicea en el año 325, la Iglesia declaró formalmente que el Hijo es "consustancial" con el Padre, es decir, que es de la misma sustancia o esencia, completamente Dios. Esto fue reafirmado en el Segundo Concilio Ecuménico en Constantinopla en el año 381, que confirmó el Credo Niceno, describiendo al Hijo como "eternamente engendrado" del Padre, "luz de luz," y "Dios verdadero de Dios verdadero," reafirmando la creencia en la plena divinidad y unidad del Hijo con el Padre.
