Saint Charles Parish Needs You and You Need Saint Charles Parish!

By registering at a parish, you are declaring your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. If you have recently moved to the area or if you are a long-time resident, please consider registering at the parish where you participate. There's usually information in a parish bulletin or in the pew racks about how to register. When in doubt, ask a priest after Mass. In most cases, you will need to visit the parish office and fill out a simple form or register online.

Top Reasons to Register at a Parish

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you. This is especially important during a time of crisis so that the pastoral staff can attend to your spiritual needs and the needs of your family.
- Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you. Providing your contact information is important so that parishes provide you timely updates via email, direct mail, phone, etc. Also, if you use offertory envelopes or online giving, you will also receive a year-end statement of your donations for income tax purposes. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.
- Registered active members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation.
- Registered active members are sometimes eligible to rent parish facilities.
- Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.

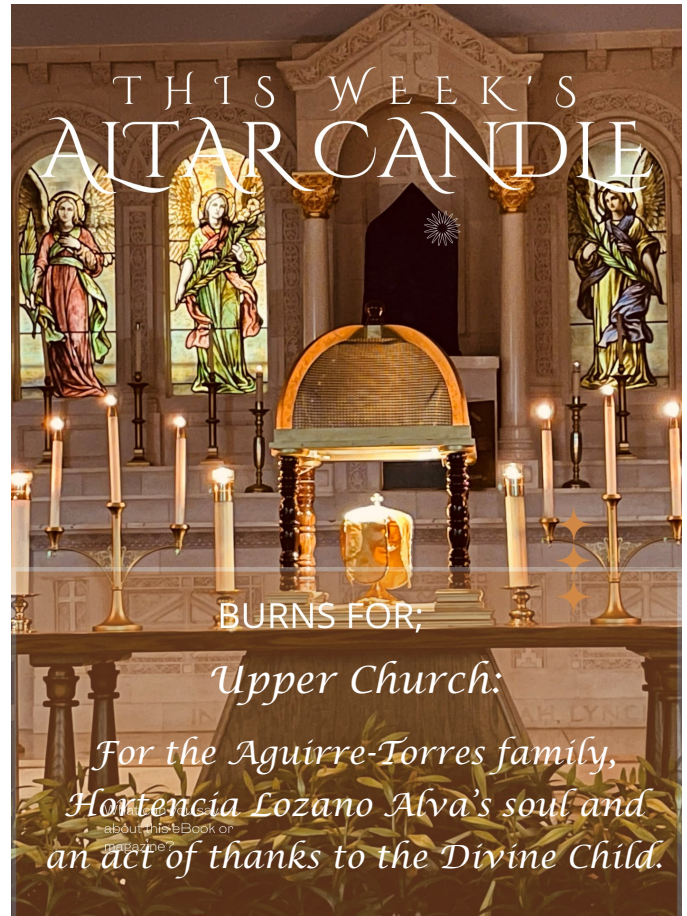

Deacon Batista Comim was born in São Paulo, Brazil to Valdinei Comim and Marcia dos Santos Batista Comim. He currently resides in Stamford. Deacon Batista Comim attended Seton University in South Orange, NJ, from which he graduated in 2015 with a bachelor of arts degree in theology. “My vocation was born through the Neocatechumenal Way community,” he said. It was through this charism that God called him to the journey of priesthood. “I grew up in a simple Catholic family in Jundiai in São Paulo state, Brazil. As an only child, I was always searching for happiness and meaning in my life. I had everything — a good job, friends, and a good career — but nothing could satisfy me.” When he heard the “Kerygma,” he realized that God loved him the way he was.



“I always thought that a priest’s life was a sad and lonely life, which I was not looking forward to. However, a missionary priest from the Neocatechumenal Way formed at the Redemptoris Mater Seminary of Brasilia in Brazil came to my parish on a Saturday night, and he shared his experience of his mission,” the deacon said. “I was moved by his happiness; I could see that he had meaning in his life. So, I asked him, ‘Are you satisfied with your life by being a priest?’ He said with a great joy, ‘Yes, because the grace of God is enough for me.’ And from that moment, I understood that God was calling me to a beautiful mission, to be a witness to his love and be grateful for what he has done in my life.”

Throughout the next few weeks, I will be inviting you to read and reflect on different letters and homilies from various saints. THE SENDING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

When the Lord told his disciples *to go and teach all nations and baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit*, he conferred on them the power of giving men new life in God. He had promised through the prophets that in these last days he would pour out his Spirit on his servants and handmaids, and that they would prophesy. So when the Son of God became the Son of Man, the Spirit also descended upon him, becoming accustomed in this way to dwelling with the human race, to living in men and to inhabiting God's creation. The Spirit accomplished the Father's will in men who had grown old in sin, and gave them new life in Christ. Luke says that the Spirit came down on the disciples at Pentecost, after the Lord's ascension, with power to open the gates of life to all nations and to make known to them the new covenant. So it was that men of every language joined in singing one song of praise to God, and scattered tribes, restored to unity by the Spirit, were offered to the Father as the first-fruits of all the nations. This was why the Lord had promised to send the Advocate: he was to prepare us as an offering to God. Like dry flour, which cannot become one lump of dough, one loaf of bread, without moisture, we who are many could not become one in Christ Jesus without the water that comes down from heaven. And like parched ground, which yields no harvest unless it receives moisture, we who were once like a waterless tree could never have lived and borne fruit without this abundant rainfall from above. Through the baptism that liberates us from change and decay we have become one in body; through the Spirit we have become one in soul. *The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and strength, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of God* came down upon the Lord, and the Lord in turn gave this Spirit to his Church, sending the Advocate from heaven into all the world into which, according to his own words, the devil too had been cast down like lightning. If we are not to be scorched and made unfruitful, we need the dew of God. Since we have our accuser, we need an advocate as well. And so the Lord in his pity for man, who had fallen into the hands of brigands, having himself bound up his wounds and left for his care two coins bearing the royal image, entrusted him to the Holy Spirit. Now, through the Spirit, the image and inscription of the Father and the Son have been given to us, and it is our duty to use the coin committed to our charge and make it yield a rich profit for the Lord.

EL ENVÍO DEL ESPÍRITU SANTO

El Señor dijo a los discípulos: Id y haced discípulos de todos los pueblos, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Con este mandato les daba el poder de regenerar a los hombres en Dios. Dios había prometido por boca de sus profetas que en los últimos días derramaría su Espíritu sobre sus siervos y siervas, y que éstos profetizarían; por esto descendió el Espíritu Santo sobre el Hijo de Dios, que se había hecho Hijo del hombre, para así, permaneciendo en él, habitar en el género humano, reposar sobre los hombres y residir en la obra plasmada por las manos de Dios, realizando así en el hombre la voluntad del Padre y renovándolo de la antigua condición a la nueva, creada en Cristo. Y Lucas nos narra cómo este Espíritu, después de la ascensión del Señor, descendió sobre los discípulos el día de Pentecostés, con el poder de dar a todos los hombres entrada en la vida y para dar su plenitud a la nueva alianza; por esto, todos a una, los discípulos alababan a Dios en todas las lenguas, al reducir el Espíritu a la unidad de los pueblos distantes y ofrecer al Padre las primicias de todas las naciones. Por esto el Señor prometió que nos enviaría aquel Defensor que nos haría capaces de Dios. Pues, del mismo modo que el trigo seco no puede convertirse en una masa compacta y en un solo pan, si antes no es humedecido, así también nosotros, que somos muchos, no podíamos convertirnos en una sola cosa en Cristo Jesús, sin esta agua que baja del cielo. Y, así como la tierra árida no da fruto, si no recibe el agua, así también nosotros, que éramos antes como un leño árido, nunca hubiéramos dado el fruto de vida, sin esta gratuita lluvia de lo alto. Nuestros cuerpos, en efecto, recibieron por el baño bautismal la unidad destinada a la incorrupción, pero nuestras almas la recibieron por el Espíritu. El Espíritu de Dios descendió sobre el Señor, Espíritu de prudencia y sabiduría, Espíritu de consejo y de valentía, Espíritu de ciencia y temor del Señor, y el Señor, a su vez, lo dio a la Iglesia, enviando al Defensor sobre toda la tierra desde el cielo, que fue de donde dijo el Señor que había sido arrojado Satanás como un rayo; por esto necesitamos de este rocío divino, para que demos fruto y no seamos lanzados al fuego; y, ya que tenemos quien nos acusa, tengamos también un Defensor, pues que el Señor encomienda al Espíritu Santo el cuidado del hombre, posesión suya, que había caído en manos de ladrones, del cual se compadeció y vendió sus heridas, entregando después los dos denarios regios para que nosotros, recibiendo por el Espíritu la imagen y la inscripción del Padre y del Hijo, hagamos fructificar el denario que se nos ha confiado, retornándolo al Señor con intereses.

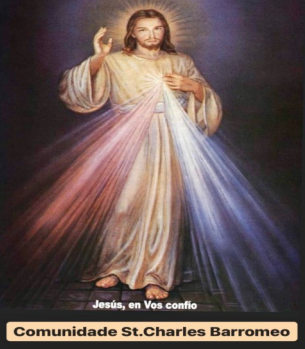
