FROM THE PASTOR'S OFFICE

Dear Friends,

I. "IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT"

The Fathers of the Church make a distinction between two important aspects of our understanding of God: theology and economy. "Theology" refers to the mystery of God's inner life within the Trinity, while "economy" refers to the works by which God reveals himself and shares his life with us. Through God's actions in the world (the economy), we come to know his divine nature (the theology), and at the same time, understanding the mystery of God's innermost being helps us better understand his works in the world.

The Trinity is one of the most profound mysteries of the Christian faith. It refers to God's existence as three persons in one divine essence: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This mystery cannot be fully known through human reasoning alone. While there are hints of God's Trinitarian nature in the creation and in the Old Testament, it is only through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, along with the sending of the Holy Spirit, that the full revelation of the Trinity becomes accessible to us.

Ultimately, the Trinity is a mystery that we can only grasp through God's revelation. As human beings, we learn about God not just from abstract ideas, but from his actions in the world, particularly through the life and work of Jesus Christ and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Just as we come to know a person better through their actions, we come to know God more deeply by recognizing how his divine life is made known through his works of creation, salvation, and ongoing presence in our lives.

DE LA OFICINA DEL PÁRROCO

Queridos Amigos,

I. "EN EL NOMBRE DEL PADRE, DEL HIJO Y DEL ESPÍRITU SANTO"

Los Padres de la Iglesia hacen una distinción entre dos aspectos importantes para entender a Dios: la teología y la economía. La "teología" se refiere al misterio de la vida interna de Dios en la Trinidad, mientras que la "economía" se refiere a las obras mediante las cuales Dios se revela y comparte su vida con nosotros. A través de las acciones de Dios en el mundo (la economía), llegamos a conocer su naturaleza divina (la teología), y entender el misterio de su ser nos ayuda a comprender mejor sus obras.

La Trinidad es uno de los misterios más profundos de la fe cristiana. Se refiere a la existencia de Dios como tres personas en una sola esencia divina: el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Este misterio no puede ser comprendido solo con la razón. Aunque hay indicios en la creación y el Antiguo Testamento, es a través de la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo, y el envío del Espíritu Santo, que se revela plenamente.

Finalmente, la Trinidad es un misterio que solo podemos entender a través de la revelación de Dios. Conocemos a Dios no solo por ideas abstractas, sino por sus acciones en el mundo, especialmente a través de Jesucristo y el Espíritu Santo. Así como entendemos mejor a una persona por sus acciones, llegamos a conocer a Dios más profundamente reconociendo cómo su vida divina se manifiesta en sus obras de creación, salvación y presencia continua.

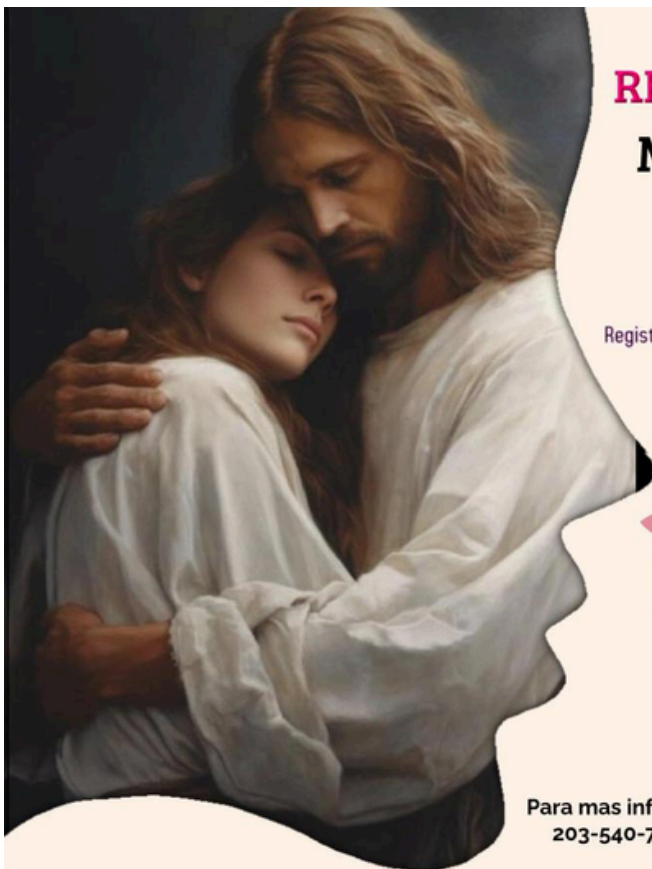
