Saint Charles Parish Needs You and You Need Saint Charles Parish!

By registering at a parish, you are declaring your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. If you have recently moved to the area or if you are a long-time resident, please consider registering at the parish where you participate. There's usually information in a parish bulletin or in the pew racks about how to register. When in doubt, ask a priest after Mass. In most cases, you will need to visit the parish office and fill out a simple form or register online.

Top Reasons to Register at a Parish

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you. This is especially important during a time of crisis so that the pastoral staff can attend to your spiritual needs and the needs of your family.
- Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you. Providing your contact information is important so that parishes provide you timely updates via email, direct mail, phone, etc. Also, if you use offertory envelopes or online giving, you will also receive a year-end statement of your donations for income tax purposes. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.
- Registered active members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation.
- Registered active members are sometimes eligible to rent parish facilities.
- Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.

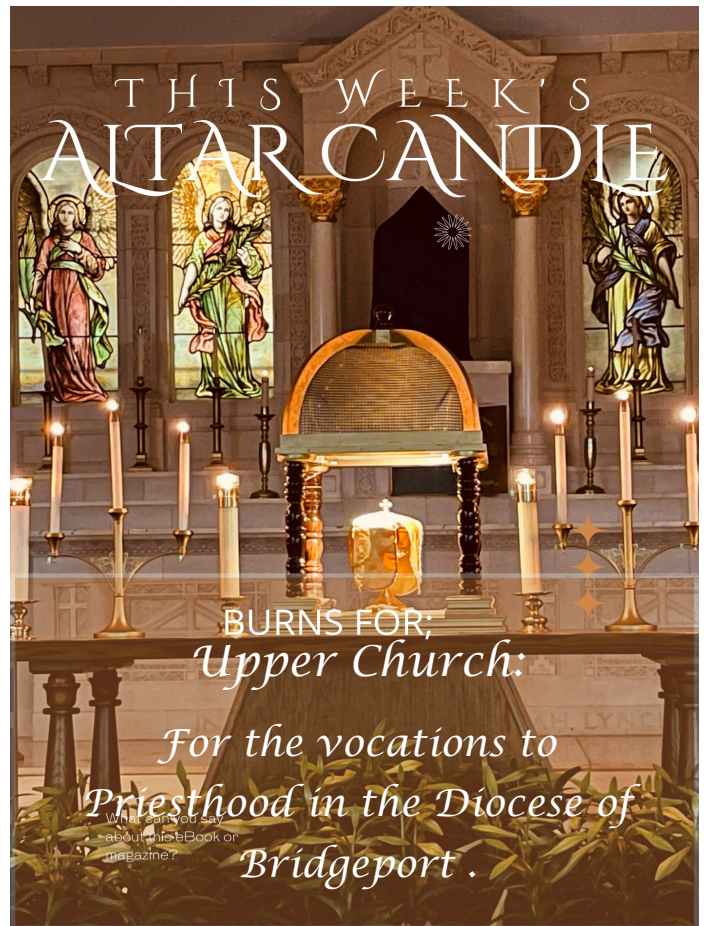

Dear brothers and sisters,

Throughout the next few weeks, I will be inviting you to read and reflect on different letters and homilies from various saints. It is important as Catholics that our church know the life and thoughts of the Saints, since we are called to be saints. We will find in them a lot of wisdom and knowledge, but they will also be of great consolation to us.

(Hom. 14, 3-6: PL 76, 1129-1130)

CHRIST THE GOOD SHEPERD

I am the good shepherd. I know my own—by which I mean, I love them—and *my own know me*. In plain words: those who love me are willing to follow me, for anyone who does not love the truth has not yet come to know it. My dear brethren, you have heard the test we pastors have to undergo. Turn now to consider how these words of our Lord imply a test for yourselves also. Ask yourselves whether you belong to his flock, whether you know him, whether the light of his truth shines in your minds. I assure you that it is not by faith that you will come to know him, but by love; not by mere conviction, but by action. John the evangelist is my authority for this statement. He tells us that *anyone who claims to know God without keeping his commandments is a liar*. Consequently, the Lord immediately adds: *As the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for my sheep*. Clearly he means that laying down his life for his sheep gives evidence of his knowledge of the Father and the Father's knowledge of him. In other words, by the love with which he dies for his sheep he shows how greatly he loves his Father. Again he says: *My sheep hear my voice, and I know them; they follow me, and I give them eternal life*. Shortly before this he had declared: *If anyone enters the sheepfold through me he shall be saved; he shall go freely in and out and shall find good pasture*. He will enter into a life of faith; from faith he will go out to vision, from belief to contemplation, and will graze in the good pastures of everlasting life. So our Lord's sheep will finally reach their grazing ground where all who follow him in simplicity of heart will feed on the green pastures of eternity. These pastures are the spiritual joys of heaven. There the elect look upon the face of God with unclouded vision and feast at the banquet of life for ever more. Beloved brothers, let us set out for these pastures where we shall keep joyful festival with so many of our fellow citizens. May the thought of their happiness urge us on! Let us stir up our hearts, rekindle our faith, and long eagerly for what heaven has in store for us. To love thus is to be already on our way. No matter what obstacles we encounter, we must not allow them to turn us aside from the joy of that heavenly feast. Anyone who is determined to reach his destination is not deterred by the roughness of the road that leads to it. Nor must we allow the charm of success to seduce us, or we shall be like a foolish traveler who is so distracted by the pleasant meadows through which he is passing that he forgets where he is going.

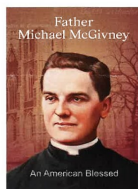
CRISTO, EL BUEN PASTOR

Yo soy el buen Pastor, que conozco a mis ovejas, es decir, que las amo, y las mías me conocen. Habla, pues, como si quisiera dar a entender a las claras: «Los que me aman vienen tras de mí». Pues el que no ama la verdad es que no la ha conocido todavía. Acabáis de escuchar, queridos hermanos, el riesgo que corren los pastores; calibrad también, en las palabras del Señor, el que corréis también vosotros. Mirad si sois, en verdad, sus ovejas, si le conocéis, si habéis alcanzado la luz de su verdad. Si le conocéis, digo, no sólo por la fe sino también por el amor; no sólo por la credulidad, sino también por las obras. Porque el mismo Juan Evangelista que nos dice lo que acabamos de oír, añade también: Quien dice «Yo le conozco», y no guarda sus mandamientos, es un mentiroso. Por ello dice también el Señor en el texto que comentamos: Igual que el Padre me conoce, y yo conozco al Padre yo doy mi vida por las ovejas. Como si dijera claramente «La prueba de que conozco al Padre y el Padre me conoce a mí está en que entrego mi vida por mis ovejas; es decir: en la caridad con que muero por mis ovejas, pongo de manifiesto mi amor por el Padre.» Y de nuevo vuelve a referirse a sus ovejas, diciendo: Mis ovejas escuchan mi voz, y yo las conozco, y ellas me siguen, y yo les doy la vida eterna. Y un poco antes había dicho: Quien entre por mí se salvará, y podrá entrar y salir, y encontrar pastos. O sea, tendrá acceso a la fe, y pasará luego de la fe a la visión, de la credulidad a la contemplación, y encontrará pastos en el eterno descanso. Sus ovejas encuentran pastos, porque quienquiera que siga al Señor con corazón sencillo se nutrirá con un alimento de eterno verdor. ¿Cuáles son, en efecto, los pastos de estas ovejas, sino los gozos eternos de un paraíso inmarchitable? Los pastos de los elegidos son la visión del rostro de Dios, con cuya plena contemplación la mente se sacia eternamente. Busquemos, por tanto, hermanos queridísimos, estos pastos, en los que podremos disfrutar en compañía de tan gran asamblea de santos. El mismo aire festivo de los que ya se alegran allí nos invita. Levantemos, por tanto, nuestros ánimos, hermanos; vuelva a enfervorizarse nuestra fe, ardan nuestros anhelos por las cosas del cielo, porque amar de esta forma ya es ponerse en camino. Que ninguna adversidad pueda alejarnos del júbilo de la solemnidad interior, puesto que, cuando alguien desea de verdad ir a un lugar, las asperezas del camino, cualesquiera que sean, no pueden impedirselo. Que tampoco ninguna prosperidad, por sugestiva que sea, nos seduzca, pues no deja de ser estúpido el caminante que, ante el espectáculo de una campiña atractiva en medio de su viaje, se olvida de la meta a la que se dirigía.
