Saint Charles Parish Needs You and You Need Saint Charles Parish!

By registering at a parish, you are declaring your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. If you have recently moved to the area or if you are a long-time resident, please consider registering at the parish where you participate. There's usually information in a parish bulletin or in the pew racks about how to register. When in doubt, ask a priest after Mass. In most cases, you will need to visit the parish office and fill out a simple form or register online.

Top Reasons to Register at a Parish

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you. This is especially important during a time of crisis so that the pastoral staff can attend to your spiritual needs and the needs of your family.
- Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you. Providing your contact information is important so that parishes provide you timely updates via email, direct mail, phone, etc. Also, if you use offertory envelopes or online giving, you will also receive a year-end statement of your donations for income tax purposes. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.
- Registered active members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation.
- Registered active members are sometimes eligible to rent parish facilities.
- Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.

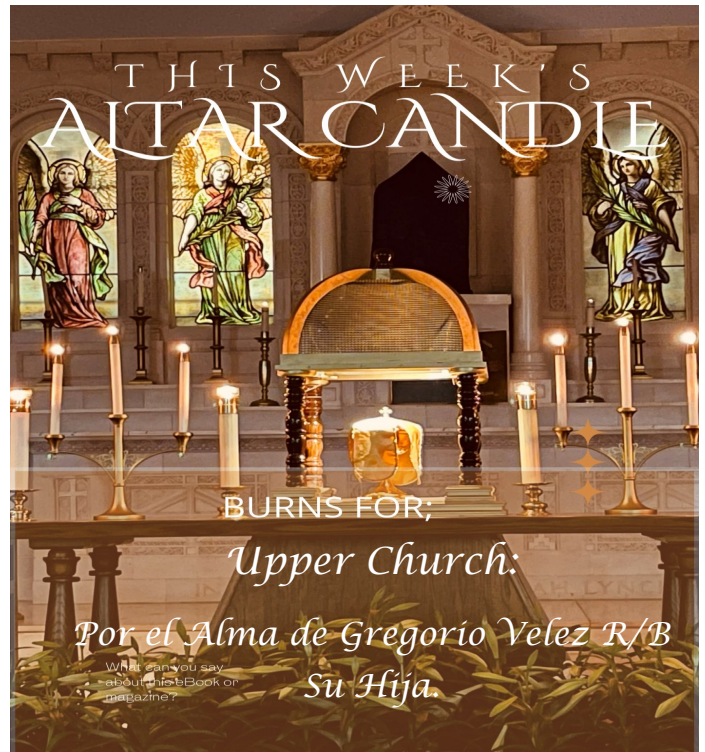

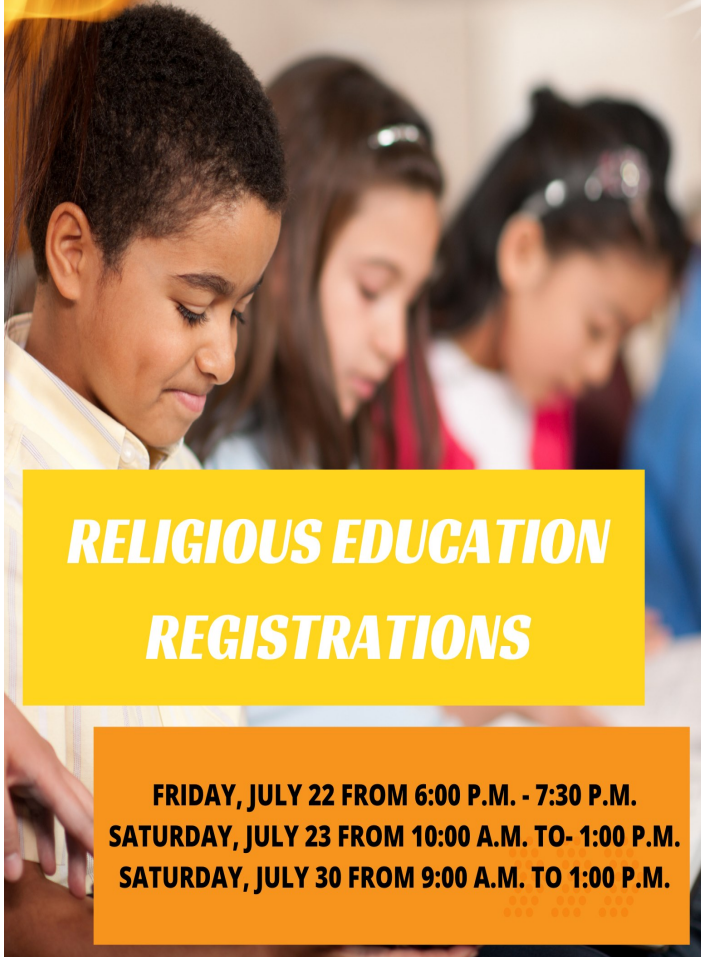

Throughout the next few weeks, I will be inviting you to read and reflect on different letters and homilies from various saints. It is important as Catholics that our church know the life and thoughts of the Saints, since we are called to be saints. We will find in them a lot of wisdom and knowledge, but they will also be of great consolation to us.

CATECHESIS ON THE RITES PRECEDING BAPTISM

We gave a daily instruction on right conduct when the readings were taken from the history of the patriarchs or the maxims of Proverbs. These readings were intended to instruct and train you, so that you might grow accustomed to the ways of our forefathers, entering into their paths and walking in their footsteps, in obedience to God's commands. Now the season reminds us that we must speak of the mysteries, setting forth the meaning of the sacraments. If we had thought fit to teach these things to those not yet initiated through baptism, we should be considered traitors rather than teachers. Then, too, the light of the mysteries is of itself more effective where people do not know what to expect than where some instruction has been given beforehand. Open then your ears. Enjoy the fragrance of eternal life, breathed on you by means of the sacraments. We explained this to you as we celebrated the mystery of "the opening" when we said: *Effetha*, that is, *be opened*. Everyone who was to come for the grace of baptism had to understand what he was to be asked, and must remember what he was to answer. This mystery was celebrated by Christ when he healed the man who was deaf and dumb, in the Gospel which we proclaimed to you. After this, the holy of holies was opened up for you; you entered into the sacred place of regeneration. Recall what you were asked; remember what you answered. You renounced the devil and his works, the world and its dissipation and sensuality. Your words are recorded, not on a monument to the dead but in the book of the living. There you saw the levite, you saw the priest, you saw the high priest. Do not consider their outward form but the grace given by their ministries. You spoke in the presence of angels, as it is written: *The lips of a priest guard knowledge, and men seek the law from his mouth, for he is the angel of the Lord almighty*. There is no room for deception, no room for denial. He is an angel whose message is the kingdom of Christ and eternal life. You must judge him, not by his appearance but by his office. Remember what he handed on to you, weigh up his value, and so acknowledge his standing. You entered to confront your enemy, for you intended to renounce him to his face. You turned toward the east, for one who renounces the devil turns toward Christ and fixes his gaze directly on him.

CATEQUESIS SOBRE LOS RITOS QUE PRECEDEN AL BAUTISMO

Hasta ahora os hemos venido hablando cada día acerca de cuál ha de ser vuestra conducta. Os hemos ido leyendo los hechos de los patriarcas o los consejos del libro de los Proverbios a fin de que, instruidos y formados por estas enseñanzas, os fuerais acostumbrando a recorrer el mismo camino que nuestros antepasados y a obedecer los oráculos divinos, con lo cual, renovados por el bautismo, os comportéis como exige vuestra condición de bautizados. Mas ahora es tiempo ya de hablar de los sagrados misterios y de explicaros el significado de los sacramentos, cosa que, si hubiésemos hecho antes del bautismo, hubiese sido una violación de la disciplina del arcano más que una instrucción. Además de que, por el hecho de cogeros desprevenidos, la luz de los divinos misterios se introdujo en vosotros con más fuerza que si hubiese precedido una explicación. Abrid, pues, vuestros oídos y percibid el buen olor de vida eterna que exhalan en vosotros los sacramentos. Esto es lo que significábamos cuando, al celebrar el rito de la apertura, decíamos: "Effetá", esto es: "Ábrete", para que, al llegar el momento del bautismo, entendierais lo que se os preguntaba y la obligación de recordar lo que habíais respondido. Este mismo rito empleó Cristo, como leemos en el Evangelio, al curar al sordomudo. Después de esto, se te abrieron las puertas del santo de los santos, entraste en el lugar destinado a la regeneración. Recuerda lo que se te preguntó, ten presente lo que respondiste. Renunciaste al diablo y a sus obras, al mundo y a sus placeres pecaminosos. Tus palabras están conservadas, no en un túmulo de muertos, sino en el libro de los vivos. Viste allí a los diáconos, los presbíteros, el obispo. No pienses sólo en lo visible de estas personas, sino en la gracia de su ministerio. En ellos hablaste a los ángeles, tal como está escrito: Labios sacerdotales han de guardar el saber, y en su boca se busca la doctrina, porque es un ángel del Señor de los ejércitos. No hay lugar a engaño ni retractación; es un ángel quien anuncia el reino de Cristo, la vida eterna. Lo que has de estimar en él no es su apariencia visible, sino su ministerio. Considera qué es lo que te ha dado, úsalo adecuadamente y reconoce su valor. Al entrar, pues, para mirar de cara al enemigo y renunciar a él con tu boca, te volviste luego hacia el oriente, pues quien renuncia al diablo debe volverse a Cristo y mirarlo de frente.

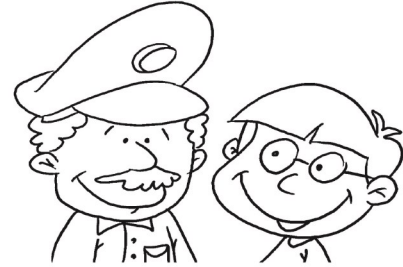

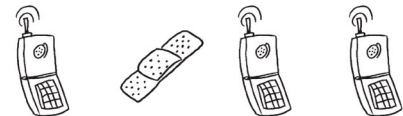

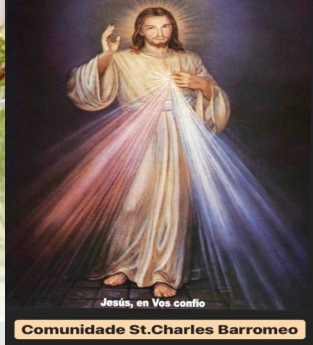
