By registering at a parish, you are declaring your desire to be part of a Catholic faith community. If you have recently moved to the area or if you are a long-time resident, please consider registering at the parish where you participate. There's usually information in a parish bulletin or in the pew racks about how to register. When in doubt, ask a priest after Mass. In most cases, you will need to visit the parish office and fill out a simple form or register online.

**Top Reasons to Register at a Parish**

- A sense of belonging and identity in a parish community.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you. This is especially important during a time of crisis so that the pastoral staff can attend to your spiritual needs and the needs of your family.
- Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you. Providing your contact information is important so that parishes provide you timely updates via email, direct mail, phone, etc. Also, if you use offertory envelopes or online giving, you will also receive a year-end statement of your donations for income tax purposes. Once you are registered, please notify the parish office of any changes in address or phone number.
- Registered active members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation.
- Registered active members are sometimes eligible to rent parish facilities.
- Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.

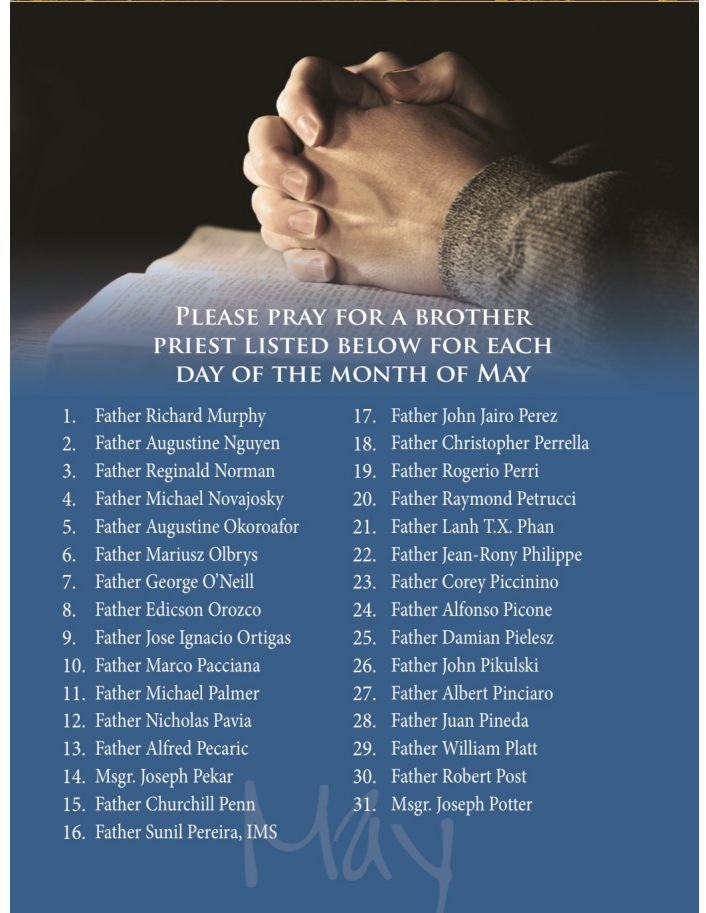
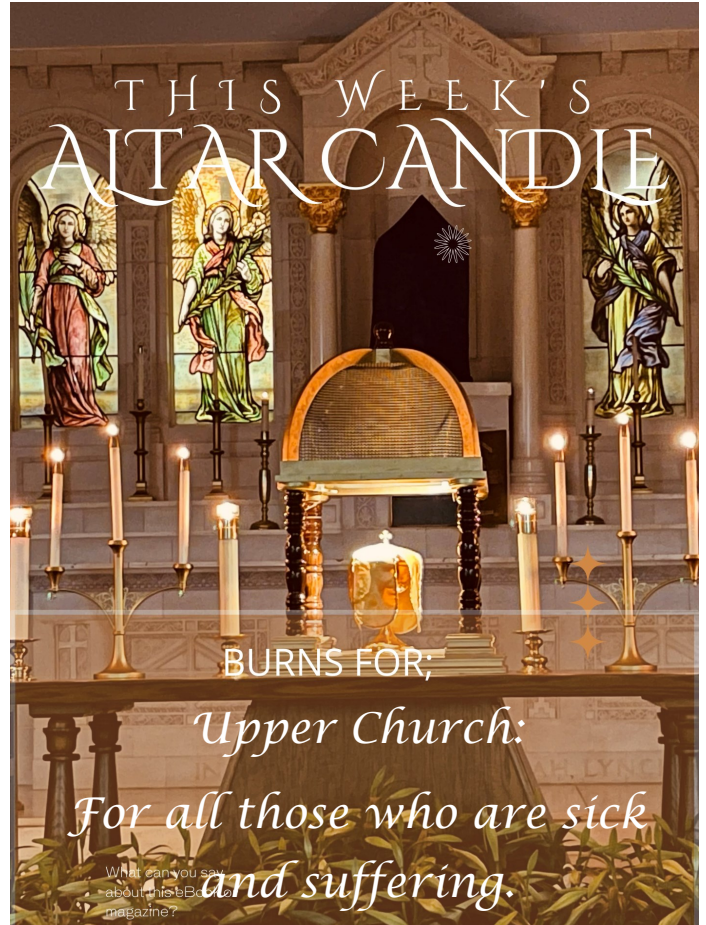

Throughout the next few weeks, I will be inviting you to read and reflect on different letters and homilies from various saints. It is important as Catholics that our church know the life and thoughts of the Saints, since we are called to be saints. We will find in them a lot of wisdom and knowledge, but they will also be of great consolation to us.

**From the commentary on the second letter of the Corinthians by Saint Cyril of Alexandria, bishop**

(Cap 5, 5-6, 2: PG74, 942-943)

***GOD HAS RECONCILED US TO HIMSELF THROUGH CHRIST AND GIVEN US THE MINISTRY OF RECONCILIATION***

Those who have a sure hope, guaranteed by the Spirit, that they will rise again lay hold of what lies in the future as though it were already present. They say: "Outward appearances will no longer be our standard in judging other men. Our lives are all controlled by the Spirit now, and are not confined to this physical world that is subject to corruption. The light of the Only-begotten has shone on us, and we have been transformed into the Word, the source of all life. While sin was still our master, the bonds of death had a firm hold on us, but now that the righteousness of Christ has found a place in our hearts we have freed ourselves from our former condition of corruptibility." This means that none of us lives in the flesh anymore, at least not in so far as living in the flesh means being subject to the weaknesses of the flesh, which include corruptibility. *Once we thought of Christ as being in the flesh, but we do not do so any longer*, says Saint Paul. By this he meant that the Word became flesh and dwelt among us; he suffered death in the flesh in order to give all men life. It was in this flesh that we knew him before, but we do so no longer. Even though he remains in the flesh, since he came to life again on the third day and is now with his Father in heaven, we know that he has passed beyond the life of the flesh; for *having died once, he will never die again, death has no power over him any more. His death was a death to sin, which he died once for all; his life is life with God*. Since Christ has in this way become the source of life for us, we who follow in his footsteps must not think of ourselves as living in the flesh any longer, but as having passed beyond it. Saint Paul's saying is absolutely true that *when anyone is in Christ he becomes a completely different person: his old life is over and a new life has begun*. We have been justified by our faith in Christ and the power of the curse has been broken. Christ's coming to life again for our sake has put an end to the sovereignty of death. We have come to know the true God and to worship him in spirit and in truth, through the Son, our mediator, who sends down upon the world the Father's blessings. And so Saint Paul shows deep insight when he says: *This is all God's doing: it is he who has reconciled us to himself through Christ*. For the mystery of the incarnation and the renewal it accomplished could not have taken place without the Father's will. Through Christ we have gained access to the Father, for as Christ himself says, no one comes to the Father except through him. *This is all God's doing*, then. *It is he who has reconciled us to himself through Christ, and who has given us the ministry of reconciliation*.

(Cap 5, 5-6, 2: PG74, 942-943)

**DIOS NOS HA RECONCILIADO POR MEDIO DE CRISTO Y NOS HA CONFIADO EL MINISTERIO DE ESTA RECONCILIACIÓN**

Los que poseen las arras del Espíritu y la esperanza de la resurrección, como si poseyeran ya aquello que esperan, pueden afirmar que desde ahora ya no conocen a nadie según la carne: todos, en efecto, somos espirituales y ajenos a la corrupción de la carne. Porque, desde el momento en que ha amanecido para nosotros la luz del Unigénito, somos transformados en la misma Palabra que da vida a todas las cosas. Y, si bien es verdad que cuando reinaba el pecado estábamos sujetos por los lazos de la muerte, al introducirse en el mundo la justicia de Cristo quedamos libres de la corrupción. Por tanto, ya nadie vive en la carne, es decir, ya nadie está sujeto a la debilidad de la carne, a la que ciertamente pertenece la corrupción, entre otras cosas; en este sentido, dice el Apóstol: Si alguna vez juzgamos a Cristo según la carne, ahora ya no. Es como quien dice: La Palabra se hizo carne y acampó entre nosotros, y, para que nosotros tuviésemos vida, sufrió la muerte según la carne, y así es como conocimos a Cristo; sin embargo, ahora ya no es así como lo conocemos. Pues, aunque retiene su cuerpo humano, ya que resucitó al tercer día y vive en el cielo junto al Padre, no obstante, su existencia es superior a la meramente carnal, puesto que murió de una vez para siempre y ya no muere más; la muerte ya no tiene dominio sobre él, porque su morir fue un morir al pecado de una vez para siempre; y su vivir es un vivir para Dios. Si tal es la condición de aquel que se convirtió para nosotros en abanderado y precursor de la vida, es necesario que nosotros, siguiendo sus huellas, formemos parte de los que viven por encima de la carne, y no en la carne. Por esto, dice con toda razón san Pablo: El que es de Cristo es una criatura nueva. Lo antiguo ha pasado, lo nuevo ha comenzado. Hemos sido, en efecto, justificados por la fe en Cristo, y ha cesado el efecto de la maldición, puesto que él ha resucitado para librarnos, conculcando el poder de la muerte; y, además, hemos conocido al que es por naturaleza propia Dios verdadero, a quien damos culto en espíritu y en verdad, por mediación del Hijo, quien derrama sobre el mundo las bendiciones divinas que proceden del Padre. Por lo cual, dice acertadamente san Pablo: Todo esto viene de Dios, que por medio de Cristo nos reconcilió consigo, ya que el misterio de la encarnación y la renovación consiguiente a la misma se realizaron de acuerdo con el designio del Padre. No hay que olvidar que por Cristo tenemos acceso al Padre, ya que nadie va al Padre, como afirma el mismo Cristo, sino por él. Y, así, todo esto viene de Dios, que por medio de Cristo nos reconcilió y nos encargó el ministerio de la reconciliación.

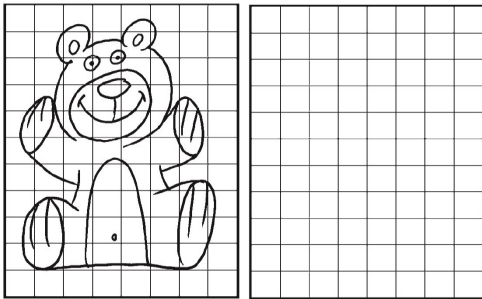

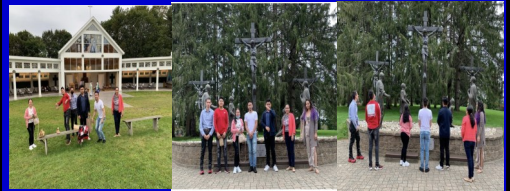
